## **Staffing updates:**

Congratulations to Mr and Mrs Jones on the birth of Benjamin Thomas Jones. Benjamin was born on Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> September 2021 weighing 7lbs 5 ounces. Both Mrs Jones and Benjamin are well.

We wish Mrs Jones a wonderful maternity leave and hope that they will both be making an appearance in a virtual celebration assembly soon!



We are pleased to welcome Mrs Hadley to our Gayton team. Mrs Hadley has been employed as a teaching assistant and will primarily be based in Year 1 in the morning periods and then will be working across the school in the afternoon periods focusing on delivering interventions across the school with a primary focus on early reading and phonics.

School Census Day- Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> October 2021- Can you help? On two days every school year, we have a school census where we complete data about the numbers of children in school and whether they are having a school meal or are eligible for an income based Free School Meal (FSM). Our funding is then paid to us from this information.



The money that the school is given in April each year to pay for the free meal, that all Infant School children get under the 'Universal Infant School Meals' scheme, is based on the average of how many children have a school meal on **Thursday 7**<sup>th</sup> **October 2021 and Thursday 20**<sup>th</sup> **January 2022.** 

We therefore need as many children as possible in F2, Y1 and Y2 to have a school dinner on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> October 2021. The kitchen will be putting together a special Italian menu and we will send this out to parents by the end of this week.

Please try to help us get the funding we need. For every child that eats a school meal on 7<sup>th</sup> October 2021. If your child always has a packed lunch, and you are worried that, if they have a school meal on 7<sup>th</sup> October, they won't like it or eat it, please feel free to send in sandwiches and they can have these if they don't like the school dinner.

This only applies to children in F2, Year 1 and Year 2.

#### **Harvest donations:**

## Reminder: Curriculum information session for parents- Week commencing 4th October 2021



We have sent home the links to the booking form for parents to register whether they will or will not be able to attend the curriculum information sessions in week commencing 4<sup>th</sup> October 2021.

#### School house name changes:

If your child was in water they will now be in Mill.




