RE: Y6 Secondary admissions information

Please find attached a powerpoint which outlines for parents the main changes to the secondary admissions process for this academic year.

It is really important that all Year 6 parents take note of the information outlined in the powerpoint.

Below I have summarised the most important information from the powerpoint:

September	On-line application system goes live. Preference forms and booklets available.
10 th October	Birkenhead High School Academy music assessments.
13 th October	St Anselms assessment
17 th & 20 th October	Upton Hall assessment
22 nd & 23 rd October	11+ Assessment
31 st October	Deadline for preference form
1 st March	Secondary allocation day.

Due to COVID-19, the dates for the selective assessments have been changed until October and all parents who have registered their child for the tests should have received an email confirming this. This now means that when parents are completing their preference form you can now select 5 schools. This can include 3 selective schools and then 2 non- selective schools. Your preferences must be made by **31st October 2020**.

If your child sits the 11+ assessments but does not meet the standard, the selective school preferences will be removed and the non-selective preferences will be automatically moved up.

I would encourage all parents to apply online as you will then receive an email on secondary allocation day informing you of your child's allocated school.
