Mrs Wright is going to be offering choir rehearsals on the following Tuesdays after school from 3:30pm- 4:15pm



# **Healthy Snacks**

It is our school policy that children can bring a healthy snack into school to have at break time. We have noticed a large number of children are now bringing snacks in to school which are not healthy and are not permitted as part of our policy.

#### Healthy snacks include:

- \*Fruit
- \*Vegetables- e.g. carrot sticks, cucumber, pepper etc
- \*Piece of bread or a wrap
- \*Breadsticks
- \*Rice cakes



Children are not allowed to have any form of the following: crisps, biscuits, chocolates or cereal bars. Please can I also remind all parents that nuts should not be brought into school as we have children who have nut allergies.

### Wellies/old trainers:

It is vital that your child has a pair of wellies or old trainers in school. As part of the curriculum and for our OPAL programme, the children will use the field in all weathers. Please ensure that your child has a pair of wellies or old trainers in school so that they can get changed and prevent their school shoes getting really dirty and also save our carpets from getting muddy when your child has been on the school field.

## Mental Health Support for children.



We now have some mental health practitioners working in school on a weekly basis. This service is provided by the NHS and is aimed at supporting pupils with low-level mental health concerns.

We are able to refer children into the service with parental consent. However, we aren't always aware of children who may benefit from the support of the mental health

practitioners as sometimes children can present and behave very differently in school compared to home. If you think your child might benefit from this service, please contact Mrs McAleny at school and we can add your child to the waiting list or just provide some further information to help you make a decision as to whether it may benefit your child.

**Communication with teachers:** If you need to contact your child's class teacher, you will be able to see them at the gates at the end of the school day. If not, you can email the school office via: schooloffice@gayton.wirral.sch.uk and the teacher will get back to you as soon as possible. Please remember that teachers are teaching all day and it may not be possible for them to call you back until the end of the school day.
