Dear Parents & Carers,

Welcome back to the start of the summer term. We hope that all our families had a good Easter break and we are looking forward to all the exciting events planned in the summer term and hopefully a little bit more sunshine as well!

#### **PTA Easter Bingo Event:**

#### Price of a school meal:

Edsential (Catering company) have informed us that they will be increasing the cost of a school meal from 1<sup>st</sup> June 2023. This is due to the exceptional food costs that they are incurring along with the rising costs of staffing. Prices will increase to **£2.68** per meal. Reception, Y1 & Y2 parents can continue to claim a universal free school meal for their child.

#### **Strike Action:**

As previously shared, school will only be partially open on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> April 2023. **School will only be open to pupils in F2, Y5 & Y6.** On the other planned strike day of **Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2023**, I can confirm that school will be fully open to all classes.

#### Sports Day: F2- Year 6.



Our F2- Year 6 sports day will be taking place on **Wednesday 21**<sup>st</sup> **June from 9:10am- 11:30am (approximately).** We may have to cancel the event due to inclement weather and a decision will be made by 8:00am on that morning. If we do cancel the event, we have scheduled in Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> June 2023 as the reserve date for our sports day. All children should wear their PE kit to school on this day and if the weather is sunny, they will need to have applied sun cream lotion. Parents/carers are invited to attend.

Y6 SAT tests- Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> May 2023 – Friday 12<sup>th</sup> May 2023. Tuesday 9th May- Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation. Wednesday 10th May- Reading Thursday 11th May- Maths- Paper 1 and Paper 2 Friday 12th May- Maths- Paper 3.

Please ensure that you child is in school on time and that they have a water bottle and a healthy snack in school each day.

KS1 SATs (Y2) will take place over a two week period from Monday 15<sup>th</sup> May-Friday 26<sup>th</sup> May 2023.

Year 1 Phonics screening- Monday 12<sup>th</sup> June – Friday 16<sup>th</sup> June 2023.

Year 4 – Multiplication check will take place over a 3 week window from Monday 5<sup>th</sup> June 2023- Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2023.
